Village Seats	Wooden/Plastic & Metal seats are subject to weather deterioration and damage by visitors	Injury to members of the public, contractors and employees	Public	M	Report any visual signs of damage to the Clerk. Organise regular visual checks of all. Seats are regularly inspected, and any remedial action undertaken to ensure the seats are maintained in a sound condition
Fouling/Hazardous Waste/Pests	deterioration and damage by visitors	Injury to members of the public, contractors and employees	Public	H	Regular litter removal to be organised. Maintained in a sound condition. Sharps to be reported
Trip or injury on paths	Visitors may be injured if they trip over objects	Injury to members of the public, contractors and employees	Public	M	Keeping footpaths regularly checked and maintained Close any footpaths that present a larger risk whilst repair work is undertaken. We carry out regular inspections to ensure paths are maintained in a safe manner in all of the Parish open spaces
Boundary Fences	Wooden / metal fences are subject to weather deterioration and damage by visitors.	Injury to members of the public, contractors and employees	Public	L	Fences are regularly inspected, and any remedial action undertaken to ensure the fences are maintained in a sound condition
Area/Grass ground surface	Visitors may be injured by uneven surface or damage to the surface	Injury to members of the public, contractors and employees	Public	L	Visual checks each visit by the contractor are reported to the Clerk for action.
Signs/Gates	The metal structure is subject to deterioration from the weather	Injury to members of the public	Public	L	Regular inspection for signs of damage and any remedial action undertaken to ensure that the sign is maintained in a good condition
